

Dear patients, in connection with the implementation of the requirements of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the EU Council 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/49 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation "GDPR"), the administrator of your personal data is APO Stomatologia sp. zoo Zuzanna Chociłowska, Joanna Janusiewicz, based at ul. Bażantów 43/1, 40-668 Katowice, NIP 9542787320, REGON 369331580 hereinafter referred to as: "Administrator". Your data is processed in order to protect your health, provide medical services, manage the provision of health services, contact you as our patient, as well as to issue medical records to persons authorized by you. We also process data in connection with maintaining and ensuring the security of the ICT system in which medical documentation is processed. The legal basis for processing the data obtained is the Act of November 16, 2008. on patient rights and the Patient Ombudsman. In addition, the law requires the Administrator to process data for statistical, accounting or tax purposes.

Your data is processed only to the extent related to the implementation of the above purposes. The data may be disclosed to persons authorized by the Administrator, e.g. doctors who are employees and co-workers, other health care entities to ensure continuity of treatment and availability of health services, as well as other entities acting on our behalf, i.e. technical laboratories, electronic medical documentation software provider, IT specialists maintenance services based on a data entrustment clause. We do not disclose your data to other recipients except entities authorized under the law.

The obligation to provide data results from applicable law, including the Act of 6 November 2008 on patient rights and the Ombudsman for Patient Rights and the Act of 27 August 2004 on health care services financed from public funds.

Providing your personal data is mandatory under the law, and the consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to settle the matter. The administrator does not intend to transfer your data to a third country or to international organizations.

Your data will be stored for no longer than necessary, i.e. for the period provided for in the Act of November 6, 2018. on patient rights and the Patient Ombudsman.

Patients have the right to access and rectify their data, the right to transfer data, the right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time as well as limit the processing of data in accordance with certain principles of sharing medical records under the provisions of Polish law. In connection with the processing of personal data by the Administrator, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the UODO, if you consider that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Regulation on the protection of personal data of April 27, 2016. Providing your personal data is mandatory under the law, and the consequence of not providing it is the Administrator's inability to provide services.

Based on the provided personal data, the Administrator will not make automated decisions regarding you resulting from profiling.
