

In connection with the implementation of the requirements of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council of the EU 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/49 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation "GDPR"), the administrator of your personal data is APO Stomatologia, based at ul. Bażantów 2, 40-668 Katowice, NIP 9542787320, REGON 369331580 hereinafter referred to as: "Administrator".

Please be advised that for reasons of broadly understood security, the area of our Cabinet is monitored. Data processing includes: part of the area located inside the facility, i.e. reception / waiting room along with the corridor and dental offices.

Entering the marked zone covered by the monitoring system is tantamount to the consent of each person to process their data in terms of image and activities that will be recorded by the cameras of the monitoring system.

Your data is processed only to the extent related to the implementation of the above purposes. We do not disclose personal data to recipients other than entities authorized by law.

Your personal data will be stored for a period not exceeding 7 days from the date of recording, and in the case where the image recordings constitute evidence in proceedings conducted on the basis of legal provisions or may constitute evidence in proceedings, the deadline indicated above shall be extended until the final completion of the proceedings.

The administrator does not intend to transfer your data to a third country or to international organizations.

Patients whose image has been registered in the monitoring system have the right to obtain information regarding data processing in terms of: rules for recording and recording information, how to secure information, as well as the ability to share collected data. You also have the right to request access to the content of your data and rectification, transfer, right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time as well as limit the processing of data in accordance with the specific principles of sharing the video monitoring record laid down by Polish law.

In connection with the processing of personal data by the Administrator, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the UODO, if you consider

that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Regulation on the protection of personal data of April 27, 2016. Based on the provided personal data, the Administrator will not make automated decisions regarding you resulting from profiling.
